Julia has many years experience of working with unemployed people, including working with the Family Employment Initiative and Nottingham CVS. Her current role as Employment and Training Outreach Worker involves her engaging with local employers, looking at their recruitment needs and working with them to deliver pre employment training to allow local unemployed people to access these job opportunities. By using a joined up approach with the employer, Jobcentre Plus, the Learning and Skills Council, Making the Connection are able to link local communities to local employment opportunities.

Julia also seconded one day a week to the Family Employment Initiative (FEI) a Coalfield Regeneration funded project working in key areas of North East Derbyshire and North Nottinghamshire including Bolsover, Shirebrook, Mansfield, Ashfield, Worksop, Killisilick and Netherfield.

### **Family Employment Initiative**

The FEI is a partnership project, working with families and individuals providing 'one to one' support to help people find suitable and sustainable employment. If people have any barriers preventing them from finding work they offer completely free, confidential support and work with the individual to help them get back into work and be better off financially. Key areas of support are:

- Helping a person find a job they want
- Information, advice and guidance
- Signposting to other suitable support agencies
- Help with CV and application forms
- Support in accessing training
- Advise on how a job will affect benefits
- Help with travel costs
