The training and tests are fully funded by the government if you:

- ✓ are aged 19 years or older
- ✓ are a British Citizen, come from an EU member country or have lived in the UK for 3 years or more (and have been given the right to remain).

This means the training and test will not cost you a thing.

How do I get a Certificate in Adult Literacy or Numeracy?

1 Call Care Training East Midlands on **0115 9599 544**.

2 You will be booked in for an initial assessment. This will assess where your strengths and weaknesses are. You can choose to do both Literacy and Numeracy or just one subject.

3 The results of the assessment will be used to create a learning plan that's tailored to you.

4 Courses can be done over several short sessions anywhere that you have access to the internet. You can also visit Care Training's **learndirect** centre Monday–Friday, 8:30am–4:30pm, to use a computer and see a tutor.

5 When you are ready you can book in for your test. This will take place at Care Training. The test consists of 40 multiple choice questions. You have one hour to finish the test.
